2799.	DEMOCRATIC TIME. A parishioner enquired if a decision had been reached regarding the diversion of traffic whilst the High Street works take place. The Chairman advised that the matter would be discussed later at the meeting. The parishioner asked if anything was being done about the channel outside Magpies the Clerk advised that she had notified Highways who were dealing with the matter. The parishioner complained about the parking outside the Bakers Arms Public House. She advised that she had a job getting off the main road into Common Road due to the amount of parked vehicles. She suggested yellow lines but the Chairman advised that this is only any good if there is someone to enforce it. The Bakers Arms have been told to discourage customers from parking in Common Road and to park in the Village Hall. There is a sign up in the Public House advising people to use the Village Hall Car Park. Cllr. Woodward advised that the Cricket Club were going to put sleepers around the Common to protect the grass. Two parishioners discussed the Flood Alleviation Plan. They advised that CCC had agreed an extension of time on the planning application. The residents of Margaretting had given their objections and got legal advice. The Chairman felt there was not sufficient time to consider an application of this size and the Parish Council needed more time to look at the documents in more depth. It was therefore decided to postpone discussing the application until the next meeting. The Chairman advised a parishioner, Mr Sharp, that the Parish Council had written to the Planning Inspectorate objecting to the decision made on diverting footpaths 11,12 and 13 at Fristling Hall. Mr Sharp advised that the whole process had been a shambles and not all paperwork had been supplied to the Planning Inspectorate. Mr Sharp advised that he would be taking out a judicial review against the decision.

It was agreed that the Clerk should ask if the Chairman could meet the team on site on the day to discuss what work needed to be carried out if not Chairman to submit a schedule of works to CCC.</p> <p>Rotating the VDS sign –. Nothing to report.</p> <p>Play in the Park – The Clerk had received an invoice from CCC for £225.00 to cover all the events held in the Summer. Cllr. Woodward advised that there had been a brilliant attendance for the 0-11 year olds but there had not been much attendance for the 12-16 age group.
