	<p><b><u>Urgent Planning Matters Not On The Agenda.</u></b></p> <p>The Chairman advised that he was speaking to Swifts about putting a bund in front of the windmill instead of posts.</p> <p>The Chairman advised that Carl Swift will be removing the No Parking signs on the green this week. He was also looking at the kissing gate by the Catholic Church and would submit a quotation to carry out the work.</p> <p>Cllr. Woodward said that heavier collars needed to be put around the trees on the Common. He stated that Carl Swift has a lot of outstanding work to do for the Parish Council.</p> <p>Cllr. Millernas reported that CCC have put posts in where the car has been parking on the green in Back Lane but they have been put in so wide you could get a bus through the gap and the posts have not been put where they should have been put. Cllr. Millernas had spoken to CCC and has a site meeting with them on Wednesday.</p> <p>Cllr. Grundy had taken up the matter of the traffic island at the top of Whites Hill with Highways. He had received a response which he thought was unacceptable and has e-mailed Highways back.</p> <p>The Chairman said he would send an E-mail to Ingatestone and Fryerning Parish Council to find out what is happening about Buttsbury Bridge. The bridge is being shut again as it has been hit again. The Chairman said it needs a joint effort to get the restriction in place. Speed and size of traffic is the problem. The Chairman suggested to Cllr. Lee that she sends a submission to the Highways Panel.</p> <p>It was reported that the circus signs have been left behind even though the circus has gone. It was suggested if any Councillor notices a sign they remove it.</p> <p>Cllr. Woodward reported that the Donkey Derby was called Stock Charity Day but last year not one Stock charity benefitted. It should therefore not be called Stock Charity Day as it is misleading.
