4228	<b>DEMOCRATIC TIME</b>  Michelle Corrigan from the Hoop pub attended the meeting to discuss making some significant changes to the Hoop Beer Festival in 2018. These changes included the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The event will be for <b>over 21's</b> and above, ID will have to be provided</li><li>- Police have been asked to help manage the area around the pub</li><li>- All shops in the village have been asked to not serve under 21's</li><li>- The festival will be contained in The Hoop's garden only.</li></ul> Cllr Richard Clark (from Billericay Parish Council) gave a presentation asking for Stock Parish Council's support for a potential Community dog park to be built on land in Goatsmoor Lane. This would primarily be used for secure dog walking, training & exercise.
